

## Looking Forward –

Last week's pew sheet went to press before our Council Meeting, so here are some of the points that were discussed there. On fundraising: the Autumn Fair on October 28<sup>th</sup> will take place at the home of Sue Mantovani. Prior to that the Harvest Festival Weekend (6-9 October) will include a Harvest Supper on the 9<sup>th</sup>, at which participants will each bring one course of a meal to add to a 'banquet.' In addition there will be an entry fee of €10, and just 35 tickets will be sold. Although the Flower Festival had made only a modest profit (€620), and even that had depended upon the advertising costs being met by an anonymous donor, it was thought that the event as a whole had much to commend it. Were there to be another such event, it should happen relatively soon – within the next few years rather than twenty years again – to keep the concept in mind, and to enable lessons learned to be put into practice. Hopefully, next year's Lent course may have a video element. In the meantime consideration is being given to a Pilgrim discipleship course being arranged.

Some new ideas for the Pastoral Group were rehearsed. The accounts were scrutinised. On most items we are just about hitting budget targets. The Gift Day total so far is disappointing. €500 each was distributed from our Tithing account to Oasis, Pasycaf (Cyprus Cancer nurses) the Boys' Home at Bethany and Cyprus Friends (offering support to Alzheimers' sufferers and their carers).

There was discussion about how we can make our toilet facilities disabled-friendly; how we could maintain our FairTrade Parish status, and new guidelines for receiving JEMT grants or loans. A full account of the Meeting is contained in the draft Minutes at the back of the church, where you will also find copies of scene@cypgulf.
