Looking Forward –

This afternoon at 4pm I shall be taking the service at St George's in the Troodos. If you fancy an afternoon out in the cool you would be most welcome. Transport may be possible. We have a Council Meeting on Thursday. Our main item will be the decision on whether to proceed with the building works in the church that will give us a modern toilet accessible to all, with special facilities for people with physical disabilities; together with a new vestry. Neither present facility is suitable for purpose. The vestry is essentially a cupboard and the toilet might have been state of the art around the time most of us were being potty trained.

Obviously, cost will be a factor, but we do need to present modern features to those who visit us, and the toilet is a particularly well used facility.

With our book sale last week, our regular parish meetings and events have now all been suspended for the Summer. Many thanks to all who give their time on a regular basis to ensuring that these events work well. Our Charity shops will remain open and we do have a need for more volunteers to help man them especially in Pervolia. If you feel you could spare a couple of hours a week, please let me know. Next Saturday, there will be an Ordination in Nicosia. This is a public service begins at 4pm and all are welcome. Justin Arnott and Peter Day, who was on placement with us, are being made Deacon.

Next Sunday the Bishop is with us. He will be issuing permissions for those who have trained for the various sanctuary offices, and presenting Fr Geoff with a contract that marks his becoming Associate Priest here, rather than Assistant Curate. Essentially, apart from the name change, the main significance is that Fr Geoff is now considered to have completed his Initial Ministerial Training. That is a milestone for him and for all of us, who have shared the journey of the last six years or so with him.
