Looking Forward –

This week, Archdeacon John is in Wales for the ordination of Gaynor Ford, where he has also been asked to preach. Gaynor and her husband Nigel have been frequent visitors to St Helena's Church over many years. Gaynor has been a Lay Reader in her diocese in Wales for quite some years but then discerned a calling to ordained ministry. We wish, hope and pray for her to enjoy her new ministry and to be enriched by her spiritual calling more closely to follow God. We had an Archdeaconry clergy meeting last Wednesday and one of the things that was discussed was the proposed Diocesan Constitution. This has been a longish-term aspiration and was a feature of this year's Synod, where the Gulf States asked for more time to consider the revisions. These were considered by the Diocesan Standing Committee a few days ago and comments made on the various (any many!) proposed changes. This will be circulated soon to Parish Councils for further consideration and then returned for ratification at the 2019 Synod in February next year. There are no changes that will have any real effect on St Helena's parish, rather that there may be some changes to overall governance in the Diocese. We had the last session of the latest round of the Pilgrim course last week (discussing the Eucharist) that the Diocese has been promoting to parishes. Those who attended reported that they had enjoyed and grown spiritually from attendance. We hope to begin the next round (of six sessions) in the Autumn and this will concentrate on the Bible, which should be fascinating and instructive to all of our spiritual lives. We are about to enter the summer season, when there are lots of departures for family time in the UK and elsewhere. I hope and pray that any visits from/to Cyprus are blessed, happy and successful.
