Today, Easter Pastoral Letter is available. Please take one for yourself and anyone else that you think might be interested. We have some unusual and innovative services. The Tenebrae service on Maundy Thursday, is a service of hymns and readings that includes a Eucharist, and takes its name from the shadows that are gathering on the eve of Good Friday. On Good Friday we have a Stations of the Cross service, replicating in liturgical fashion the journey Jesus made from his trial to the cross. On Sunday evening we have a Songs of Praise service in Pervolia. Any or all of these could be interesting services for those who have not participated in them before. Our main Easter Eucharist celebration is of course on Easter Day at 9.30am.

Our next Pastoral afternoon will be on Tuesday. These afternoons offer an opportunity to speak, listen or consider together a variety of pastoral issues. The theme for Tuesday is 'Random acts of kindness'. The Lent course continues on Thursday.
