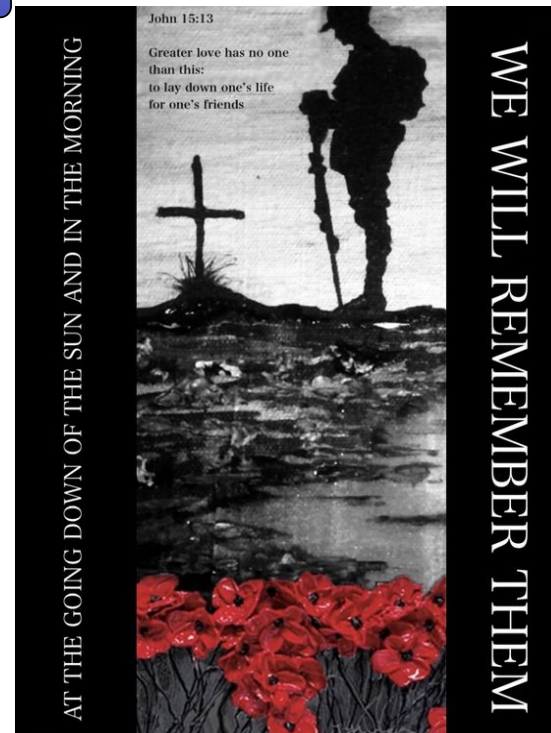
Post Communion Prayer
