An account of last week's Council Meeting will appear in next week's pew sheet. I have to spend much of this coming week in the Gulf, with a whistle stop tour through Bahrain Sharjah and Abu Dhabi. Next week our guest celebrant will be our old friend Rev'd Tony Jaynes.

As people return over the next few weeks our weekday church programme will gain momentum. One new venture is 'Afternoon Tea'. This has resulted from our Pastoral Afternoons, and particularly the one on dementia, where the plight of carers was especially highlighted. The Afternoon Teas will be an opportunity simply to meet and converse with tea and the kind of homemade food you would expect at afternoon tea. We want to offer them for free to anyone who wishes to come. It is important that they are not regarded for 'the lonely and isolated'. If that were so no-one would come, because no-one wants to be thought of as that sad. We all have our pride. And in fact, we all have a need for community and fellowship. We hope that contributions of food will be forthcoming, and there will be announcements about how we intend to organise that in due course. The first of the Teas will be on Thursday 27th September at 4pm in the Upper Room. The next Pastoral Afternoon will be on 1st October at 2pm, when the subject will be 'ageing'.
