### **Looking Forward –**

Today we welcome Archbishop Barry Morgan as our guest preacher. He and I have been colleagues for most of our respective ministries, and it is a special pleasure to welcome him to St Helena's.

Of necessity, I am writing these notes before Synod. The Bishop intends to make an announcement during Synod about my successor. In the notices today I shall be able to share what until now has been embargoed, about who the next Chaplain will be and when he will be starting here.

During the coming week we have Luncheon Club on Wednesday. Our 10 minute speaker will be Wendy Papasolomontou, who will be telling us about her recent pilgrimage across northern Spain. Names for Wednesday should be given to Wendy. Next month we shall revert to a first Wednesday date. That will mean that we meet on Ash Wednesday. We shall have our Eucharist with ashing at 12 noon on that day, prior to the lunch. As is our custom, we shall show the Diocesan video on that occasion rather than have a speaker.
