It will be good to be back with you today. The next few Sundays will see a number of guests and visitors at our Eucharist. Next week Bishop Michael is our celebrant and preacher. On February 3rd we usually play host to a few early arrivals at Synod, and on February 10th our guest preacher will be the former Archbishop of Wales, Dr Barry Morgan.
