Looking Forward –

In January I will be facilitating a new Exploring Faith learning group. We shall be starting with 'Beginning the New Testament'. Then during 2020 following it with courses in 'Doing Theology' and 'Global Anglicanism'. Each course has a basic book to read through and discuss section by section. You would be welcome to participate in the reading and discussions as a good way of developing your knowledge of theology in the Anglican Communion. There is much to look forward to, including Carols at St George's Troodos, the Christingle, a Carol Service in the Pervolia Charity Shop, the Ladies Carol Service, St Helena's Carol Service.
